- Addresses current issues and trends in the afterschool field; i.e.: STEM, college/career readiness, professional development, classroom management, assessment and evaluation, leadership, school safety, etc.
- Likelihood that the topic will be of interest to conference attendees
- Innovative/cutting-edge issues
- Degree to which the program has achieved positive results
- Degree of participant involvement such as hands-on learning and interactive discussion
- Practical usefulness to participants

We strongly encourage limiting the use of PowerPoint to better supplement audience participation. Provide a general overview of your topic and have groups share what they have done or discussed. Presenters are responsible for duplicating and providing copies of all handouts to participants.
