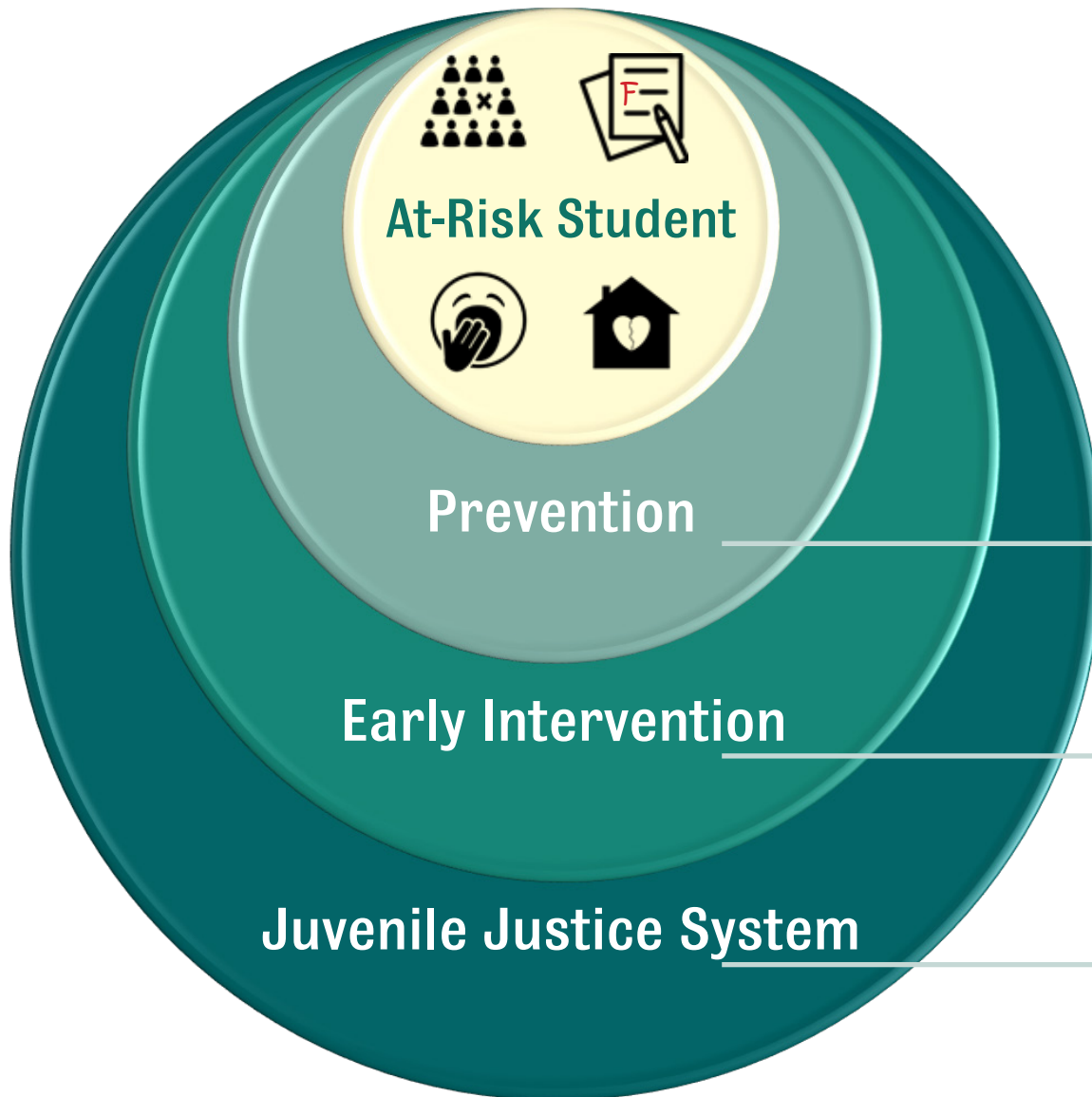


The Juvenile Justice Ecosystem

- Chronic Absenteeism
- Low Engagement in the Classroom
- Behavior Management Issues
- Low Achievement Scores
- Family and Home Issues

..as early as kindergarten

1st Tier Services - \$

- School District, including Behavior Intervention Teams (BIT)
- Family Involvement
- **Afterschool Programs**
*\$800/child/year, serving >14,000 children in 2016**
- Special Education Services: Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- Wrap-around services
- County Prevention Coalitions

2nd Tier Services - \$\$

- School District and Special Education Services: IEPs, BITs, etc.
- **Afterschool Programs**
- Wrap-around services
- County Prevention Coalitions
- Department of Family Services

3rd Tier Services - \$\$\$\$\$

- Department of Family Services
*\$9,660/child/year, serving 1855 children in 2016**

- County Youth Services
- Law Enforcement
- Court System
- Residential Facilities
