
# The Juvenile Justice Ecosystem

- Chronic Absenteeism
- Low Engagement in the Classroom
- Behavior Management Issues
- Low Achievement Scores
- Family and Home Issues

..as early as kindergarten

#### 1st Tier Services - \$

- School District, including Behavior Intervention Teams (BIT)
- Family Involvment
- Afterschool Programs \$800/child/year, serving >14,000 children in 2016\*
- Special Education Services: Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- Wrap-around services
- County Prevention Coalitions

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Tier Services - \$\$

- School District and Special Education Services: IEPs, BITs, etc.
- Afterschool Programs
- Wrap-around services
- County Prevention Coalitions
- Department of Family Services

#### 3rd Tier Services - \$\$\$\$\$

- Department of Family Services \$9,660/child/year, serving 1855 children in 2016\*
