#### Early Adversity Increases Physical, Mental, Behavioral Problems, Scientists Report







Over 17,000 study participants

The ACE Study confirms, with scientific evidence, that adversity early in life increases physical, mental and behavioral problems later in life.








## ACE Score = Number of ACE Categories

## Domestic Violence In Wyoming (2015 data)




#### Data

- In Wyoming in 2016 we had 974 substantiated cases of abuse and neglect
- Of the substantiated cases, the three top reasons for entry into the system are
  - Substance abuse by adult care givers
  - Domestic Violence
  - Mental health issues of the adult care giver
